

SUCCESS 'YOUNG DEVELOPMENT PROFESSIONALS' PROGRAMME 2019 - Media & Communications

Sindh Union Council and Community Economic Strengthening Support (SUCCESS) is a six year long (2015 - 2021) programme funded by the European Union (EU) and implemented by Rural Support Programmes Network (RSPN), National Rural Support Programme (NRSP), Sindh Rural Support Organisation (SRSO) and Thardeep Rural Development Programme (TRDP) in eight districts of Sindh, namely: Kambar Shahdado, Larkana, Dadu, Jamshoro, Matiari, Sujawal, Tando Allahyar and Tando Muhammad Khan. SUCCESS aims to work exclusively with the rural women of Sindh based on the RSPs' approach to social mobilisation, which centers on the belief that poor people have an innate potential to help themselves. This work has helped us develop a Poverty Reduction Strategy (PRS) and a dedicated Community-Driven Local Development (CDLD) policy to aid the Government of Sindh, with the assistance of Ernst & Young, the technical assistance partner for SUCCESS.

With a wide and ever-increasing reach of the programme, functions such as communications remain a critical element for SUCCESS' implementation. This requires successful planning, execution, and dissemination of the process and impact of programme interventions and components to beneficiaries as well as a wider audience of stakeholders which include political parties, government officials, community and business leaders, and mass media. As part of its communication outreach, SUCCESS-RSPN component aims to engage recent graduates as Young Development Professionals (YDPs) who have a passion to highlight the work of rural women in Sindh and be a part of the largest poverty-reduction initiative in Sindh to better development outcomes.

- Recent university graduates with a degree in social sciences or media and communications
- Possess technical and creative skills in digital content creation, graphic design, video editing, photography, press release, briefs, factsheet and report writing
- Possess knowledge of media, political and development landscape in Pakistan, especially in Sindh and at federal level
- Have interest in digital, print and electronic media management
- Display excellent language skills in English and Urdu, and working knowledge of Sindhi
- Willing to travel to programme areas in Sindh

03 months, with a possibility of extension up to 06 months

This is an Islamabad-based paid position. The YDPs are paid a stipend of PKR 30,000 per month upon satisfactory completion and approval of tasks and projects by the Programme Manager.

The cost of field travel will be borne by SUCCESS.
